A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
7 for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Office of the
8 State Fire Marshal, as follows:

21 Section 10. The sum of \$780,900, or so much thereof as
22 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention
23 Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for costs and
24 expenses related to or in support of a public safety shared

1 services center.

2 Section 20. The sum of \$225,000, or so much thereof as
 3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois
 4 Firefighters' Memorial Fund to the Office of the State Fire
 5 Marshal for expenses related to the maintenance of the
 6 Illinois Firefighters' Memorial, holding the annual Fallen
 7 Firefighter Ceremony, and other expenses as allowed under
 8 Public Act 91-0832.

9 Section 25. The following named amounts, or so much
 10 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
 11 to the Office of the State Fire Marshal as follows:

7 Section 30. The following named amounts, or so much
 8 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
 9 for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Office of the
 10 State Fire Marshal, as follows:

21 Section 35. The sum of \$1,000, or so much thereof as may
 22 be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund
 23 to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for grants available

1 for the development of new fire districts.

2 Section 40. The sum of \$550,000, or so much thereof as
3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Underground
4 Storage Tank Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for
5 a grant to the City of Chicago for Administrative Costs
6 incurred as a result of the State's Underground Storage
7 Program.

8 Section 45. The sum of \$125,000, or so much thereof as
9 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention
10 Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for grants
11 available for costs and services related to ILEAS/MABAS
12 administration.

13 Section 50. The sum of \$25,000, or so much thereof as
14 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention
15 Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for grants
16 available for the NITE project.

17 Section 55. The sum of \$5,000, or so much thereof as may
18 be necessary, is appropriated from the Cigarette Fire Safety
19 Standard Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for the
20 purpose of fire safety and prevention programs.

1 Section 60. The sum of \$76,900, or so much thereof as
2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Service and
3 Small Equipment Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal
4 for the purpose of providing small equipment grants.

5 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
6 2010.
