6 Illinois Chapter of the American Academy of Pediatrics from  
7 1994 to 1996; he was also named Physician of the Year by the  
8 AAP's Illinois chapter; and

10 Clinical Professor of both Pediatrics and Pediatric Nutrition  
11 with the Division of Nutritional Sciences at the University of  
12 Illinois at Urbana-Champaign, where he has served on various

14 courses, and participated in and provided medical oversight in  
15 nutrition research; he also served as Clinical Education Center  
16 Director and as Curriculum Leader/Co-leader of the University  
17 of Illinois College of Medicine and is a member of the Graduate  
18 College at the University of Illinois; and

19           WHEREAS, Dr. Terry Hatch has served as a member and Chair  
20 of the Illinois State Medical Society's CME Accreditation  
21 Committee; he has served on the ISMS Committee on Workforce  
22 Issues; he is also active with the American Heart Association's
