- 11 WHEREAS, In 2004, the National Association of Towns and
- 12 Townships presented him with the Grassroots Government
- 13 Leadership Award at its annual conference in Washington, D.C.;
- and this award is presented to one individual in the country
- each year, and he was the only person from Illinois to have

- 17 WHEREAS, George Porter is a charter member and served as
- 18 Chairman of the Inter-Agency Paratransit Coordinating Council,
- 19 whose mission is to improve paratransit services in DuPage
- 20 County; he was recognized in 2003 by the DuPage Center for
- 21 Independent Living for having an outstanding commitment to the
- 22 Americans with Disabilities Act; and he also received the
- 23 "Ramp-Arts" Award from the City of Naperville Mayor's Advisory
