5 WHEREAS, He was born on September 18, 1943 in Chicago, the 6 son of Dennis J. and Margaret Scott Morrissey; he married Elsie 7 Campbell in 1984; he was a 1961 graduate of Loyola Academy in 8 Wilmette, where he was co-captain of the football team; and

WHEREAS, He joined the Jesuit Society of Jesus from 1961 to 1968; during his time in the Jesuit seminary at Milford, Ohio, he obtained a bachelor degree in Classics (Latin and Greek); he taught English and Sociology at St. Xavier High School and coached soccer during this time; and

WHEREAS, He graduated from Boston College in 1967 with a degree in Philosophy; he received his Juris Doctor in 1974 from Creighton University Law School in Omaha, Nebraska; he practiced law in Elmhurst and was a Cook County Assistant State's Attorney before marrying Elsie (Campbell) in 1984; he practiced family law in Sandwich for 22 years; and

WHEREAS, In 1994, he ran for Circuit Court Judge for the 16th Judicial Circuit and for De Kalb County State's Attorney
