1 HOUSE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois House of 3 Representatives are pleased to congratulate the citizens of 4 Clinton as they celebrate the 175th anniversary of their 5 community; and

WHEREAS, In 1834, two men from McLean County were returning to their homes after doing business in Decatur when they stopped to rest; Jesse Fell, a Bloomington lawyer and land speculator, and State Representative James Allen rested on a mound of land that today is in the 400 block of North Center Street in Clinton; and

WHEREAS, James Allen was an admirer of DeWitt Clinton, then governor of New York and the mind behind the building of the Erie Canal; the two men decided to form a community on the spot and to call it Clinton and to name the county DeWitt; and

WHEREAS, Clinton was platted in 1835; throughout the years the community grew, and in 1853 the Illinois Central Railroad laid track through the community and brought in new families and business opportunities; and

WHEREAS, Land was donated for Weldon Springs State Park between 1850 and 1860; the Revere Corporation, Wallace Business

- 1 Forms, Todd Manufacturers, and many other businesses formed the
- 2 Industrial Park, expanding the community; and
- 3 WHEREAS, The Clinton Nuclear Power Plant was built in the
- 4 1980s, adding Clinton Lake as a recreational area; today the
- 5 community has a radio station, the YMCA, a library, movie
- 6 theaters, parks, a hospital, a golf course, and a country club;
- 7 the Apple and Pork Festival is held annually, drawing visitors
- 8 to the community; therefore, be it
- 9 RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
- 10 NINETY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we
- 11 congratulate the citizens of Clinton on this historic event and
- 12 wish them continued growth and prosperity for years to come;
