1 HOUSE RESOLUTION

- WHEREAS, Each year, an estimated 250 people fall through ice-covered bodies of water and drown; most are boys between the ages of 6 and 15 years; and
- 5 WHEREAS, On February 19, 2010, Kathy Kohler Baxmeyer, her 6 son, Kadin, and Kadin's best friend, Austin, all drowned after 7 ice gave way on a frozen pond, the boys fell through, and 8 Kadin's mom tried to save them; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Project SKiPPeR was created out of that tragedy
  10 and is an educational program that will go into schools and
  11 teach children about the dangers of ice-covered water; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Project SKiPPeR is an acronym for "stay calm, kick 13 like a swimmer, aim for ice edge, prop arms onto ice opening, 14 pull yourself up onto ice, exit the water, roll away"; 15 therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
  NINETY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we
  respectfully request that the State Board of Education inform
  school districts about Project SKiPPeR; and be it further
