- 5 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Used Tire
- 6 Management Fund to the University of Illinois for costs and
- 7 expenses related to or in support of mosquito research and
- 8 abatement.
- 9 Section 120. The sum of \$425,000, or so much thereof as
- 10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Hazardous Waste
- 11 Research Fund to the University of Illinois for its ordinary
- 12 and contingent expenses.
- 13 Section 125. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as
- 14 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General
- 15 Professions Dedicated Fund to the Board of Trustees of the
- 16 University of Illinois for costs associated with the
- 17 development, support or administration of pharmacy practice
- 18 education or training programs for the College of Medicine at
- 19 Rockford."; and
- 20 by replacing all of Article 93 with the following:

- Section 5. The amount of \$56,923,600, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Board of the Trustees of Western Illinois University to meet its operational expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011.
- Section 100. The amount of \$10,000, or so much thereof
  as may be necessary, is appropriated from the State College
  and University Trust Fund to the Board of Trustees of Western
  Illinois University for scholarship grant awards from the
  sale of collegiate license plates.".
