1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 1211

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 1211, AS AMENDED,
3 by replacing all of Article 12 with the following:

4 "ARTICLE 12

5 Section 5. The amount of \$39,906,400, or so much thereof
6 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
7 Fund to the Board of the Trustees of Chicago State University
8 to meet its operational expenses for the fiscal year ending
9 June 30, 2011.

10 Section 100. The sum of 307,000, or so much thereof as
11 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General
12 Professions Dedicated Fund to the Board of Trustees of
13 Chicago State University for all costs associated with the

1 development, support or administration of pharmacy practice
2 education or training programs."; and

3 by replacing all of Article 17 with the following:

4 "ARTICLE 17

5 Section 5. The amount of \$2,512,200, or so much thereof
6 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
7 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board to meet its
8 operational expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30,

Section 100. The amount of \$10,000, or so much thereof
8 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the State College
9 and University Trust Fund to the Board of Trustees of Western
10 Illinois University for scholarship grant awards from the
