1 AN ACT concerning education.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Board of Higher Education Act is amended by adding Section 9.33 as follows:
- 6 (110 ILCS 205/9.33 new)
- Sec. 9.33. Collaborative Baccalaureate Degree Development
- 8 Grant Program.
- 9 <u>(a) The Board shall implement and administer a grant</u>
- 10 program, to be referred to as the Collaborative Baccalaureate
- 11 <u>Degree Development Grant Program, to help deliver upper</u>
- 12 <u>division courses and bachelor's degree programs offered by</u>
- 13 bachelor's degree-granting colleges and universities at a
- 14 <u>location geographically convenient to student populations</u>
- currently being served by existing public community colleges.
- The Board shall adopt rules regarding eligibility criteria and
- a process for the annual application and awarding of grants.
- 18 The grant application and award process shall be as efficient
- 19 <u>as possible to encourage collaborative applications and shall</u>
- 20 <u>include consideration of existing programs and facilities.</u>
- 21 (b) A grant application must be jointly submitted by one
- 22 public community college and one or more public or private,
- 23 not-for-profit, 4-year colleges or universities.

- (c) Grants may be used for any combination of the 1
- 2 following:
- (1) Instructional space on or near a community college. 3
- 4 (2) Required training and advanced education of
- 5 faculty for the new programs.
- 6 (3) Instructional technology tools.
- 7 (4) Marketing and promotion for joint efforts.
- 8 (5) Other purposes related to the collaboration
- 9 efforts, as allowed by the Board's program rules.
- 10 (d) In order to better ensure the commitment of the
- partnering institutions, the Board shall require that each 11
- 12 partnering institution (both the community college and the
- 13 4-year institution or institutions) must also invest in the
- 14 partnership. Each grant application must include how the
- State's grant will be matched by dollars from the partner 15
- 16 institutions. The combined investment of the partner
- 17 institutions must equal no less than 50% of the amount of the
- 18 grant.
- (e) The Board shall adopt any rules that are necessary for 19
- 20 the implementation of this Section.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 21
- 22 becoming law.
