Amends the Department of Revenue Law of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois. Removes provisions placing limitations on the police powers of Department of Revenue investigators. Effective immediately.

AN ACT concerning State government.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Department of Revenue Law of the Civil
Administrative Code of Illinois is amended by changing Section
2505-305 as follows:

8 Sec. 2505-305. Investigators.

9 (a) The Department has the power to appoint investigators to conduct all investigations, searches, seizures, arrests, 10 and other duties imposed under the provisions of any law 11 administered by the Department or the Illinois Gaming Board. 12 13 These Except as provided in subsection (c), these investigators 14 have and may exercise all the powers of peace officers solely for the purpose of enforcing taxing measures administered by 15 16 the Department or the Illinois Gaming Board.

17 (b) The Director must authorize to each investigator 18 employed under this Section and to any other employee of the 19 Department exercising the powers of a peace officer a distinct 20 badge that, on its face, (i) clearly states that the badge is 21 authorized by the Department and (ii) contains a unique 22 identifying number. No other badge shall be authorized by the 23 Department.

1	(c) Investigators appointed under this Section who are
2	assigned to the Illinois Gaming Board have and may exercise all
3	the rights and powers of peace officers, provided that these
4	powers shall be limited to offenses or violations occurring or
5	committed on a riverboat or dock, as defined in subsections (d)
6	and (f) of Section 4 of the Riverboat Gambling Act.
