1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 2494

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend Senate Bill 2494, AS AMENDED,  
3 with reference to page and line numbers of House Amendment No.  
4 1, as follows:

5 on page 4, lines 23 through 25, by deleting "or has received a  
6 School Choice Voucher in the previous school year"; and

7 on page 5, by replacing lines 7 through 18 with the following:  
8 "qualifying pupil."; and

9 on page 5, by replacing line 25 with the following:  
10 "School Choice Voucher"; and

11 on page 6, line 1, by deleting "qualifying pupil"; and

12 on page 6, line 13, after "voucher", by inserting "for each  
13 qualifying pupil enrolled in a nonpublic school"; and

1 on page 6, line 14, after "in", by inserting "Section 35 of";  
2 and

3 on page 6, line 21, after "voucher", by inserting "for each  
4 qualifying pupil"; and

5 on page 9, by replacing lines 3 and 4 with the following:  
6 "year divided by the total average daily attendance used in the  
7 calculation of general State aid for City of Chicago School  
8 District 299 for the previous fiscal year or"; and

9 on page 9, by replacing lines 19 through 22 with the following:

10 "Section 50. Longitudinal data system. Recognized  
11 nonpublic schools participating in this Act must participate in  
12 the longitudinal data system established under the P-20  
13 Longitudinal Education Data System Act by disclosing data to  
14 the State Board of Education for those students attending a  
15 nonpublic school on a School Choice Voucher issued under this  
16 Act."; and

17 on page 10, by replacing line 1 with the following:

18 "Section 51. Funding.

19 (a) The total cost of the School Choice"; and

1 on page 10, immediately below line 4, by inserting the  
2 following:

3 "(b) Nonpublic schools participating in the School Choice  
4 Program must report the attendance of students with School  
5 Choice Vouchers to City of Chicago School District 299 in the  
6 manner requested by the district."; and

7 on page 107, immediately below line 3, by inserting the  
8 following:

9 "(3) Beginning in Fiscal Year 2012, the Average Daily  
10 Attendance figure for general State aid calculation purposes  
11 for City of Chicago School District 299 must be comprised of  
12 the Average Daily Attendance as calculated under paragraphs (1)  
13 and (2) of this subsection (C) plus the monthly average of the  
14 actual number of pupils in attendance in nonpublic schools from  
15 the prior year under a school choice voucher. However, students  
16 enrolled in nonpublic schools must not be considered enrolled  
17 in City of Chicago School District 299 for any purpose other  
18 than the calculation of general State aid. The Average Daily  
19 Attendance claim of City of Chicago School District 299 shall  
20 include the combined figure."
