1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 3222

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend Senate Bill 3222 by replacing  
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The University of Illinois Act is amended by  
5 changing Section 25 as follows:

6 (110 ILCS 305/25)

7 Sec. 25. Limitation on tuition increase. This Section  
8 applies only to those students who first enroll after the  
9 2003-2004 academic year. For 5 ~~4~~ continuous academic years  
10 following initial enrollment (or for undergraduate programs  
11 that require more than 5 ~~4~~ years to complete, for the normal  
12 time to complete the program, as determined by the University),  
13 the tuition charged an undergraduate student who is an Illinois  
14 resident shall not exceed the amount that the student was  
15 charged at the time he or she first enrolled in the University.  
16 However, if the student changes majors during this time period,

1 the tuition charged the student shall equal the amount the  
2 student would have been charged had he or she been admitted to  
3 the changed major when he or she first enrolled.

5 Section 10. The Southern Illinois University Management  
6 Act is amended by changing Section 15 as follows:

7 (110 ILCS 520/15)

8 Sec. 15. Limitation on tuition increase. This Section  
9 applies only to those students who first enroll after the  
10 2003-2004 academic year. For 5 ~~4~~ continuous academic years  
11 following initial enrollment (or for undergraduate programs  
12 that require more than 5 ~~4~~ years to complete, for the normal  
13 time to complete the program, as determined by the University),  
14 the tuition charged an undergraduate student who is an Illinois  
15 resident shall not exceed the amount that the student was  
16 charged at the time he or she first enrolled in the University.  
17 However, if the student changes majors during this time period,  
18 the tuition charged the student shall equal the amount the  
19 student would have been charged had he or she been admitted to  
20 the changed major when he or she first enrolled.

22 Section 15. The Chicago State University Law is amended by  
23 changing Section 5-120 as follows:

2 Sec. 5-120. Limitation on tuition increase. This Section

4 2003-2004 academic year. For 5 ~~4~~ continuous academic years  
5 following initial enrollment (or for undergraduate programs  
6 that require more than 5 ~~4~~ years to complete, for the normal  
7 time to complete the program, as determined by the University),  
8 the tuition charged an undergraduate student who is an Illinois  
9 resident shall not exceed the amount that the student was  
10 charged at the time he or she first enrolled in the University.  
11 However, if the student changes majors during this time period,  
12 the tuition charged the student shall equal the amount the  
13 student would have been charged had he or she been admitted to  
14 the changed major when he or she first enrolled.

19 Sec. 10-120. Limitation on tuition increase. This Section  
20 applies only to those students who first enroll after the  
21 2003-2004 academic year. For 5 ~~4~~ continuous academic years  
22 following initial enrollment (or for undergraduate programs  
23 that require more than 5 ~~4~~ years to complete, for the normal

1 time to complete the program, as determined by the University),  
2 the tuition charged an undergraduate student who is an Illinois  
3 resident shall not exceed the amount that the student was  
4 charged at the time he or she first enrolled in the University.  
5 However, if the student changes majors during this time period,  
6 the tuition charged the student shall equal the amount the  
7 student would have been charged had he or she been admitted to  
8 the changed major when he or she first enrolled.

10 Section 25. The Governors State University Law is amended  
11 by changing Section 15-120 as follows:

15 2003-2004 academic year. For 5 ~~4~~ continuous academic years  
16 following initial enrollment (or for undergraduate programs  
17 that require more than 5 ~~4~~ years to complete, for the normal  
18 time to complete the program, as determined by the University),  
19 the tuition charged an undergraduate student who is an Illinois  
20 resident shall not exceed the amount that the student was  
21 charged at the time he or she first enrolled in the University.  
22 However, if the student changes majors during this time period,  
23 the tuition charged the student shall equal the amount the  
24 student would have been charged had he or she been admitted to

1 the changed major when he or she first enrolled.

4 changing Section 20-125 as follows:

5 (110 ILCS 675/20-125)

6 Sec. 20-125. Limitation on tuition increase. This Section  
7 applies only to those students who first enroll after the  
8 2003-2004 academic year. For 5 4 continuous academic years  
9 following initial enrollment (or for undergraduate programs  
10 that require more than 5 4 years to complete, for the normal  
11 time to complete the program, as determined by the University),  
12 the tuition charged an undergraduate student who is an Illinois  
13 resident shall not exceed the amount that the student was  
14 charged at the time he or she first enrolled in the University.  
15 However, if the student changes majors during this time period,  
16 the tuition charged the student shall equal the amount the  
17 student would have been charged had he or she been admitted to  
18 the changed major when he or she first enrolled.

20 Section 35. The Northeastern Illinois University Law is  
21 amended by changing Section 25-120 as follows:

1           Sec. 25-120. Limitation on tuition increase. This Section

3 2003-2004 academic year. For 5 ~~4~~ continuous academic years  
4 following initial enrollment (or for undergraduate programs  
5 that require more than 5 ~~4~~ years to complete, for the normal  
6 time to complete the program, as determined by the University),  
7 the tuition charged an undergraduate student who is an Illinois  
8 resident shall not exceed the amount that the student was  
9 charged at the time he or she first enrolled in the University.  
10 However, if the student changes majors during this time period,  
11 the tuition charged the student shall equal the amount the  
12 student would have been charged had he or she been admitted to  
13 the changed major when he or she first enrolled.

15           Section 40. The Northern Illinois University Law is amended

18           Sec. 30-130. Limitation on tuition increase. This Section  
19 applies only to those students who first enroll after the  
20 2003-2004 academic year. For 5 ~~4~~ continuous academic years  
21 following initial enrollment (or for undergraduate programs  
22 that require more than 5 ~~4~~ years to complete, for the normal  
23 time to complete the program, as determined by the University),  
24 the tuition charged an undergraduate student who is an Illinois

1 resident shall not exceed the amount that the student was  
2 charged at the time he or she first enrolled in the University.  
3 However, if the student changes majors during this time period,  
4 the tuition charged the student shall equal the amount the  
5 student would have been charged had he or she been admitted to  
6 the changed major when he or she first enrolled.

8 Section 45. The Western Illinois University Law is amended  
9 by changing Section 35-125 as follows:

10 (110 ILCS 690/35-125)

11 Sec. 35-125. Limitation on tuition increase. This Section  
12 applies only to those students who first enroll after the  
13 2003-2004 academic year. The tuition charged an undergraduate  
14 student who is an Illinois resident shall not exceed the amount  
15 that the student was charged at the time he or she first  
16 enrolled at the University as an Illinois resident if that  
17 student first enrolled not more than 4 ~~3~~ and one-half academic  
18 years before. However, if the student changes majors during  
19 this time period, the tuition charged the student shall equal  
20 the amount the student would have been charged had he or she  
21 been admitted to the changed major when he or she first  
22 enrolled.
