1 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 114
2 (As Amended by Senate Amendment No. 1)

3 WHEREAS, The State Board of Education has filed its Report
4 on Waiver of School Code Mandates, dated March 1, 2010, with
5 the Senate, the House of Representatives, and the Secretary of
6 State of Illinois as required by Section 2-3.25g of the School
7 Code; therefore, be it

8 RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-SIXTH GENERAL
9 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
10 CONCURRING HEREIN, that the appeal of an administrative rule
11 waiver request made by Elgin SD 46 - Kane with respect to
12 transitional bilingual education that was denied by the State
13 Board of Education, identified in the report filed by the State
14 Board of Education as request WM200-5289-3A, is denied; and be
15 it further

16 RESOLVED, That each of the school district waiver requests
17 identified below by school district name and by the identifying
18 number and subject area of the waiver request as summarized in
19 the report filed by the State Board of Education is approved
20 for only one year and disapproved for the remaining years:

13 RESOLVED, That the request made by Elgin SD U-46 - Kane
14 with respect to driver education - behind-the-wheel
15 instruction, identified in the report filed by the State Board
16 of Education as request WM100-5289-2, is approved for only one
17 year and for the substitution of only 4 hours of
18 behind-the-wheel instruction with 16 hours of simulator use and
19 is disapproved for the remaining years and hour; and be it
20 further

21 RESOLVED, That the request made by Palatine CCSD 15 - Cook
22 with respect to physical education, identified in the report
23 filed by the State Board of Education as request WM100-5294, is
24 approved; however, this approval shall not be interpreted as

1 General Assembly approval of the merits of the district's
2 non-uniform recess policy.
