## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

ILCON Art. XIII, Sec. 9 new

Proposes to amend the General Provisions Article of the Illinois Constitution to provide that a marriage can only be between one man and one woman. Provides that the uniting of persons of the same sex in a civil union, domestic partnership, or other similar same sex relationship shall not be valid or recognized in Illinois. Effective upon being declared adopted.

RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING HEREIN, that there shall be submitted to the electors of the State for adoption or rejection at the general election next occurring at least 6 months after the adoption of this resolution a proposition to add Section 9 to Article XIII of the Illinois Constitution as follows:

- 10 ARTICLE XIII
- 11 GENERAL PROVISIONS
- 12 (ILCON Art. XIII, Sec. 9 new)
- 13 SECTION 9. SAME SEX MARRIAGE

14 <u>Only marriage between one man and one woman shall be valid</u> 15 <u>or recognized in Illinois. The uniting of persons of the same</u> 16 <u>sex in a civil union, domestic partnership, or other similar</u> 17 <u>same sex relationship shall not be valid or recognized in</u> 18 <u>Illinois.</u>
