2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois Senate are saddened to 3 learn of the death of Ronald H. McBride of Glen Carbon, who 4 passed away on February 23, 2009; and

WHEREAS, He was born January 28, 1948, in Chester, 5 6 Pennsylvania; he married Patricia Hoffmann on June 3, 1967, in 7 Mineral Wells, Texas; he was an officer in the United States 8 Army, serving two tours of duty in the Vietnam War as a 9 helicopter pilot, then continued his military career for 26 10 years; during that time he was stationed at various bases in 11 Texas, Georgia, Alabama, and in Germany, where he was an ROTC instructor and worked as a comptroller before retiring at the 12 rank of Lt. Colonel; and 13
