WHEREAS, He was a past Livingston County board member, appointed in 1982 and serving until 2000; he served as County Board chairman from December of 1994 until 1988; and WHEREAS, He loved to attend his grandchildren's
activities; and

WHEREAS, Roger Brown is survived by his wife, Margery; his son, Paul (Linda) Brown; his daughter, Angela (Tony) Padula; and his grandchildren, Dana, Corey, and Seth Brown and Lauren and Nicole Padula; therefore, be it
