WHEREAS, He accepted Jesus as his Savior at Zoe Christian Fellowship City Church in Atlanta, Georgia; he continued to serve in the ministry of the church and worked in its sound 13 booth; and

attended Campbell High School in Smyrna, WHEREAS, He Georgia, where he participated in the International Baccalaureate program for 3 years, played Spartans football and wrestled for 4 years, and, in his junior year, won the Regional Wrestling Championship for the 275-pound weight class while weighing only 225 pounds; and

WHEREAS, He attended the University of West Georgia, where he played for the West Georgia Wolves football team and joined
