WHEREAS, Scott was a standout athlete as a member of the Belleville Township High School West Class of 1975; he played with the 1975 Belleville Hillgards American Legion State baseball champions; he attended Eastern Illinois University in Charleston, earning a bachelor of science degree in accounting, and began a 23 year career with the State of Illinois in 1982; and

WHEREAS, He worked as a travel aide to Governor Jim Thompson before ascending through various positions in the Department of Banks and Trusts and the Department of Revenue; he left the State of Illinois and joined Fast Enterprises in 2005; in 2008, Fast Enterprises moved Scott and his family to Little Rock as the project director for the AIRS project; and
