2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois Senate are saddened to 3 learn of the death of the "Queen of Gospel" Dr. Albertina 4 Walker of Chicago, who passed away on October 8, 2010; and

5 WHEREAS, She was born in Chicago in 1929; at the age of 4 6 she began singing in the children's choir at West Point Baptist 7 Church; and

8 WHEREAS, At the age of 22 she formed her own gospel group, 9 Caravans, at the urging of gospel singer Mahalia Jackson; their 10 many songs included: "*Sweeping Through the City*", "*Mary Don't* 11 *You Weep*", and "*Lord Keep Me Day By Day*"; and

12 WHEREAS, After a successful career with the Caravans she 13 embarked on a solo career that included the release of songs 14 such as "*I've Got A Feeling Everything Will Be Alright*", "*Jesus* 15 *Will Fix It*", "*Please Be Patient With Me*", and "*I Can Go To God* 16 *In Prayer*"; and
