3	learn of the death of Carl L. Matthews, of Ottawa, Chicago, and
4	Glencoe, who passed away on June 26, 2010; and
5	WHEREAS, He was born on December 21, 1918, the eldest child
6	of Carl and Hessie Matthews; he served his country proudly in
7	the Air Corp in Europe during World War II; and
8	WHEREAS, After his time in World War II, he returned to
9	Ottawa and met Marguerite Hughes, who would be his wife of 61
10	years; they were wed on August 6, 1949, settled in Chicago, and
11	Carl began his career with Mutual Trust Life Insurance, an
12	association which ended upon Carl's retirement 25 years ago;

14	WHEREAS, Carl and Margy were devoted members of the
15	Catholic faith and served as Co-Presidents of the Chicago
16	Federation of the Christian Family Movement; and
17	WHEREAS, Carl Matthews devoted his second career as a
18	volunteer with the Howard Area Community Center, where the
19	annual "Volunteer of the Year" award is now named in his honor;
