SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

30 ILCS 105/5.786 new 625 ILCS 5/3-696 new

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code and the State Finance Act. Provides for the issuance of U.S. Air Force license plates to Illinois residents who meet eligibility requirements to be prescribed by the Secretary of State. Provides that an applicant shall be charged an additional fee of \$20 at original issuance and renewal. Provides that \$15 of the original issuance fee and \$2 of the renewal fee shall be deposited into the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund. Provides that \$5 of the original issuance fee and \$18 of the renewal fee shall be deposited into the Octave Chanute Aerospace Heritage Fund. Creates the Octave Chanute Aerospace Heritage Fund as a special fund in the State treasury. Provides that money in the Octave Chanute Aerospace Heritage Fund shall be paid as grants to the Octave Chanute Aerospace Heritage Fund shall be paid as grants to the Octave Chanute Aerospace Heritage Foundation of Illinois for operational and program expenses of the Chanute Air Museum. Effective immediately.

FISCAL NOTE ACT

1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The State Finance Act is amended by adding
- 5 Section 5.786 as follows:
- 6 (30 ILCS 105/5.786 new)
- Sec. 5.786. The Octave Chanute Aerospace Heritage Fund.
- 8 Section 10. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding
- 9 Section 3-696 as follows:
- 10 (625 ILCS 5/3-696 new)
- 11 Sec. 3-696. U.S. Air Force License Plates.
- 12 (a) The Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and
- applications made in the form prescribed by the Secretary of
- 14 State, may issue special registration plates designated as U.S.
- 15 Air Force license plates to residents of Illinois who meet
- 16 eligibility requirements prescribed by the Secretary of State.
- 17 The special plate issued under this Section shall be affixed
- 18 only to passenger vehicles of the first division, motor
- vehicles of the second division weighing not more than 8,000
- 20 pounds, and recreational vehicles as defined by Section 1-169
- of this Code. Plates issued under this Section shall expire

- 1 <u>according to the multi-year procedure established by Section</u>
- 2 <u>3-414.1 of this Code.</u>
- 3 (b) The design, color, and format of the plates shall be
- 4 wholly within the discretion of the Secretary of State, except
- 5 that the U.S. Air Force emblem shall appear on the plates. The
- 6 Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow the plates to be
- 7 issued as vanity or personalized plates in accordance with
- 8 Section 3-405.1 of this Code. The plates are not required to
- 9 <u>designate "Land Of Lincoln"</u>, as prescribed in subsection (b) of
- 10 Section 3-412 of this Code. The Secretary shall prescribe the
- 11 eligibility requirements and, in his or her discretion, shall
- 12 approve and prescribe stickers or decals as provided under
- 13 Section 3-412.
- 14 (c) An applicant shall be charged a \$20 fee for original
- issuance in addition to the applicable registration fee. Of
- 16 this additional fee, \$15 shall be deposited into the Secretary
- of State Special License Plate Fund and \$5 shall be deposited
- 18 into the Octave Chanute Aerospace Heritage Fund. For each
- 19 registration renewal period, a \$20 fee, in addition to the
- 20 appropriate registration fee, shall be charged. Of this
- 21 additional fee, \$2 shall be deposited into the Secretary of
- 22 State Special License Plate Fund and \$18 shall be deposited
- into the Octave Chanute Aerospace Heritage Fund.
- 24 (d) The Octave Chanute Aerospace Heritage Fund is created
- as a special fund in the State treasury. All moneys in the
- 26 Octave Chanute Aerospace Heritage Fund shall be paid, subject

- 1 to appropriation by the General Assembly and approval by the
- 2 <u>Secretary, as grants to the Octave Chanute Aerospace Heritage</u>
- 3 Foundation of Illinois for operational and program expenses of
- 4 the Chanute Air Museum.
- 5 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 6 becoming law.
