| 3 | everything after the enacting clause with the following: |
| 4 | "Section 5. The Department of Natural Resources |
| 5 | (Conservation) Law of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois |
| 6 | is amended by adding Section 805-555 as follows: |
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| 7 | (20 ILCS 805/805-555 new) |
| 8 | Sec. 805-555. Entrance fees. |
| 9 | (a) The General Assembly finds that a dedicated funding |
| 10 | stream shall be established for the operation and maintenance |
| 11 | of State parks to help ensure that these State treasures will |
| 12 | be properly maintained and remain accessible to the public for |
| 13 | generations to come. |
| 14 | (b) The Department may charge an annual vehicle admission |
| 15 | fee for access to properties owned, managed, leased, or all by |
| 16 | the Department. |

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| 1 | (c) The Department may charge a daily access fee to |
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| 2 | pedestrians and to the owners of vehicles that do not have a |
| 3 | current annual vehicle sticker. |
| 4 | (d) The Department may establish a fee for individuals who |
| 5 | use a park without paying the annual vehicle admission fee or |
| 6 | daily access fee. |
| 7 | (e) Revenue generated by the annual vehicle admission and |
| 8 | daily access fee shall be deposited into the State Parks Fund |
| 9 | or the Wildlife and Fish Fund, a special fund in the State |
| 10 | treasury. |
| 11 | (f) The Department may adopt any rules necessary to |
| 12 | implement these fees. |
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| 13 | Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, |
