2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Tobacco Products Manufacturers' Escrow
Enforcement Act of 2003 is amended by changing Section 5 as
follows:

7 (30 ILCS 167/5)

Sec. 5. Findings; purpose. The The General Assembly finds 8 9 that violations of the Tobacco Product Manufacturers' Escrow Act threaten the integrity of the tobacco Master Settlement 10 Agreement, the fiscal soundness of the State, and the public 11 health. The General Assembly finds that enacting procedural 12 enhancements will help prevent violations and aid the 13 14 enforcement of the Tobacco Product Manufacturers' Escrow Act and thereby safeguard the Master Settlement Agreement, the 15 16 fiscal soundness of the State, and the public health. The 17 provisions of this Act are not intended to and shall not be interpreted to amend the Tobacco Product Manufacturers' Escrow 18 19 Act.
