AN ACT concerning criminal law.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Code of Criminal Procedure of 1963 is 5 amended by changing Section 108A-10 as follows:

6 (725 ILCS 5/108A-10) (from Ch. 38, par. 108A-10)

Sec. 108A-10. Appeal by State. In addition to any other right to appeal, <u>the</u> the State shall have the right to appeal from a denial of an application for an order of authorization or approval and the right to appeal the granting of a motion to suppress.

Where the State appeals, such appeal shall be taken within 30 days after the date the order was denied or motion granted and shall be diligently prosecuted.
