2 (25 ILCS 10/9 new) 3 Sec. 9. Rules Committee; advancing legislative measures. 4 Upon concurrence of a majority of those appointed to the Rules 5 Committee of the House, the Rules Committee may advance any legislative measure pending before it to the House, without 6 referral to another committee; the Rules Committee, however, 7 8 shall not so report any bill that has never been favorably 9 reported by or discharged from a standing committee or a 10 special committee of the House or recommended for action by a 11 joint committee of the House and Senate. A bill advanced to the 12 House shall be placed on the daily calendar of the House on the 13 order on which it appeared before it was re-referred to the 14 Rules Committee. A floor amendment, joint action motion for 15 final action, or conference committee report advanced to the House by the Rules Committee may be considered for adoption no 16 sooner than one hour after the Clerk of the House announces the 17 18 report of the Rules Committee referring the legislative measure 19 to the House.".
