

97TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2011 and 2012 HB1114

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

25 ILCS 10/8 new

Amends the General Assembly Operations Act. Provides that if a bill or other legislative measure is sponsored or co-sponsored by a majority of the members elected to the chamber in which the bill or other legislative measure then resides, then that bill or other legislative measure must be referred by the appropriate committee of that chamber to a standing committee and a vote on that bill or other legislative measure must be taken by that standing committee within 6 session days or before any committee action or floor action deadline that has been imposed in that chamber, whichever is sooner.

1 AN ACT concerning State government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The General Assembly Operations Act is amended by adding Section 8 as follows:
- 6 (25 ILCS 10/8 new)
- 7 Sec. 8. Legislative measures; majority of members sponsor. If a bill or other legislative measure is sponsored or 8 9 co-sponsored by a majority of the members elected to the 10 chamber in which the bill or other legislative measure then 11 resides, then that bill or other legislative measure must be 12 referred by the appropriate committee of that chamber to a standing committee and a vote on that bill or other legislative 13 14 measure must be taken by that standing committee within 6 session days or before any committee action or floor action 15 16 deadline that has been imposed in that chamber, whichever is 17 sooner.
