SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

35 ILCS 200/15-190 new

Amends the Property Tax Code. Provides that each parcel of property that qualifies for a homestead exemption under the Code shall have a minimum equalized assessed value of \$1,000 after each applicable homestead exemption is applied to the property. Effective immediately.

- 4 Section 5. The Property Tax Code is amended by adding
- 5 Section 15-190 as follows:

- 7 Sec. 15-190. Minimum equalized assessed valuation.
- 8 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, beginning in
- 9 taxable year 2011, each parcel of property that qualifies for a
- 10 homestead exemption provided under this Article 15 shall have a
- 11 minimum equalized assessed value of \$1,000 after each
- 12 applicable homestead exemption is applied to the property.
- 13 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 14 becoming law.
