SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

410 ILCS 535/18.5

Amends the Vital Records Act to provide that the electronic reporting system for death registrations shall be used to transfer information to the Department of Healthcare and Family Services not less often than once every 3-month period for the purpose of updating the roster of Medicaid recipients.

FISCAL NOTE ACT MAY APPLY

1 AN ACT concerning public health.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Vital Records Act is amended by changing Section 18.5 as follows:
- 6 (410 ILCS 535/18.5)

7 18.5. Electronic reporting system for death 8 registrations. The State Registrar shall facilitate death 9 registration by implementing an electronic reporting system. 10 The system may be used to transfer information to individuals institutions responsible for completing and 11 12 certificates and related reports for deaths that occur in the State. The system shall be used to transfer information to the 13 14 Department of Healthcare and Family Services not less often than once every 3-month period for the purpose of updating the 15 ${\tt roste}{\tt roste}{\tt roste}{\tt medicaid}$ recipients. The system shall be capable of 16 17 storing and retrieving accurate and timely data and statistics for those persons and agencies responsible for vital records 18 19 registration and administration. Upon establishment of such an 20 electronic reporting system, but not later than January 1, 21 2011, the county clerk in the county in which a death occurred 22 or the county clerk of the county where a decedent last resided, as indicated on the decedent's death certificate, 23

- 1 shall be authorized to issue certifications of death records
- 2 from such system, and the State Registrar shall cause the
- 3 electronic reporting system to provide for such capability. The
- 4 Department of Financial and Professional Regulation shall have
- 5 access to the system to enhance its enforcement of the Cemetery
- 6 Oversight Act.
