2	AMENDMENT NO Amend House Bill 1261, AS AMENDED, by
3	replacing everything after the enacting clause with the
4	following:
5 6	"Section 5. The Vital Records Act is amended by changing Section 8 as follows:
7	(410 ILCS 535/8) (from Ch. 111 1/2, par. 73-8)
8	Sec. 8. Each local registrar shall:
9	(1) Appoint one or more deputies to act for him in his
10	absence or to assist him. Such deputies shall be subject to all
11	rules and regulations governing local registrars.
12	(2) Appoint one or more subregistrars when necessary for
13	the convenience of the people. To become effective, such
14	appointments must be approved by the State Registrar of Vital
15	Records. A subregistrar shall exercise such authority as is
16	given him by the local registrar and is subject to the

supervision and control of the State Registrar of Vital
 Records, and shall be liable to the same penalties as local
 registrars, as provided in Section 27 of this Act.

4 (3) Administer and enforce the provisions of this Act and
5 the instructions, rules, and regulations issued hereunder.

6 (4) Require that certificates be completed and filed in 7 accordance with the provisions of this Act and the rules and 8 regulations issued hereunder.

(5) Prepare and transmit monthly an accurate copy of each 9 10 record of live birth, death, and fetal death to the county 11 clerk of his county. He shall also, in the case of a death of a person who was a resident of another county, prepare an 12 13 additional copy of the death record and transmit it to the 14 county clerk of the county in which such person was a resident. 15 In no case shall the county clerk's copy of a live birth record 16 include the section of the certificate which contains 17 information for health and statistical program use only. In any jurisdiction that operates a public transit system, the 18 19 registrar must transmit monthly a list of decedent names and 20 addresses to the director of any mass transit agency that administers a reduced transit fare, no fare, or paratransit 21 22 program for the purpose of updating the rosters of such 23 programs.

(7) Prepare, file, and retain for a period of at least 10
years in his own office an accurate copy of each record of live

birth, death, and fetal death accepted for registration. Only in those instances in which the local registrar is also a full time city, village, incorporated town, public health district, county, or multi-county health officer recognized by the Department may the health and statistical data section of the live birth record be made a part of this copy.

7 (8) Transmit monthly the certificates, reports, or other
8 returns filed with him to the State Registrar of Vital Records,
9 or more frequently when directed to do so by the State
10 Registrar of Vital Records.

11 (8.5) Transmit monthly to the State central register of the 12 Illinois Department of Children and Family Services a copy of 13 all death certificates of persons under 18 years of age who 14 have died within the month.

(9) Maintain such records, make such reports, and perform
such other duties as may be required by the State Registrar of
Vital Records.
