

97TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2011 and 2012 HB1366

Introduced 2/9/2011, by Rep. Donald L. Moffitt

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/6-118

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Increases the fee for an original or renewal driver's license from \$30 to \$35. Provides that \$5 of the new \$35 fee shall be deposited into the Fire Prevention Fund.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

deposited into the Drunk and Drugged Driving Prevention Fund. However, for a person whose license or privilege to operate a motor vehicle in this State has been suspended or revoked for a second or subsequent time for a violation of Section 11-501 or 11-501.1 of this Code or Section 9-3 of the Criminal Code of 1961, \$190 of the \$500 fee for reinstatement of a license summarily suspended under \$500 Section 11-501.1, and \$190 of the fee for reinstatement of a revoked license shall be deposited into the Drunk and Drugged Driving Prevention Fund. \$190 of the \$500 fee for reinstatement of a license summarily revoked pursuant to Section 11-501.1 shall be deposited into the Drunk and Drugged Driving Prevention Fund.
