## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

210 ILCS 85/6.21

Amends the Hospital Licensing Act. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning umbilical cord blood donation.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 2 represented in the General Assembly: 3

- 4 Section 5. The Hospital Licensing Act is amended by 5 changing Section 6.21 as follows:
- (210 ILCS 85/6.21) 6
- 7 Sec. 6.21. Umbilical cord blood donation.
- (a) All licensed hospitals shall offer a pregnant patient 8 9 the the option to donate, to a publicly accessible certified cord blood bank, blood extracted from the umbilical cord 10 following the delivery of a newborn child if the donation can
- 11
- be made at no expense to the patient or hospital for collection 12
- 13 or storage.
- 14 (b) Nothing in this Section obligates a hospital to collect
- umbilical cord blood if, in the professional judgment of a 15
- 16 physician licensed to practice medicine in all its branches or
- 17 a nurse, the collection would threaten the health of the mother
- or child. 18
- 19 (c) Nothing in this Section imposes a requirement upon any
- 20 hospital employee, physician, nurse, or hospital that is
- 21 directly affiliated with a bona fide religious denomination
- 22 that includes as an integral part of its beliefs and practices
- the tenet that blood transfer is contrary to the moral 2.3

- 1 principles the denomination considers to be an essential part
- 2 of its beliefs.
- 3 (d) Subject to appropriations for that purpose, the
- 4 Department of Public Health shall make the maximization of
- 5 umbilical cord blood donations a public health goal. All
- 6 licensed hospitals and birthing centers shall cooperate with
- 7 the Department of Public Health in implementing this goal of
- 8 increasing donations of umbilical cord blood.
