SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/3-696 new

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides for the issuance of Police Medal of Valor plates to residents of Illinois who meet eligibility requirements prescribed by the Secretary of State. Provides that in addition to the appropriate registration fees, an applicant for the special plate shall be charged an original issuance fee of \$25 and a fee of \$25 for each renewal. Provides that \$10 of the additional original issuance fee and \$23 of the renewal fee shall be deposited into the Drivers Education Fund. Provides that \$15 of the original issuance fee and \$2 of the renewal fee shall be deposited into the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund. Effective immediately.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 10. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding
Section 3-696 as follows:

(625 ILCS 5/3-696 new) 6 7 Sec. 3-696. Police Medal of Valor license plates. (a) The Secretary, upon receipt of an application made in 8 9 the form prescribed by the Secretary, may issue special 10 registration plates designated as Police Medal of Valor license plates to residents of Illinois who meet eligibility 11 12 requirements prescribed by the Secretary of State. The special plates issued under this Section shall be affixed only to 13 14 passenger vehicles of the first division and motor vehicles of the second division weighing not more than 8,000 pounds. Plates 15 issued under this Section shall expire according to the 16 17 multi-year procedure established by Section 3-414.1 of this 18 Code. 19 (b) The design and color of the plates is wholly within the 20 discretion of the Secretary. The Secretary may allow the plates 21 to be issued as vanity or personalized plates under Section 22 3-405.1 of this Code. The plates are not required to designate

3-412 of this Code. The Secretary shall prescribe stickers or 1 2 decals as provided under Section 3-412 of this Code. 3 (c) An applicant for the special plate shall be charged a 4 \$25 fee for original issuance in addition to the appropriate registration fee. Of this fee, \$10 shall be deposited into the 5 6 Drivers Education Fund and \$15 shall be deposited into the 7 Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund, to be used by the Secretary to help defray the administrative processing 8 9 costs. For each registration renewal period, a \$25 fee, in 10 11 addition to the appropriate registration fee, shall be charged. 12 Of this fee, \$23 shall be deposited into the Drivers Education 13 Fund and \$2 shall be deposited into the Secretary of State 14 Special License Plate Fund.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon becoming law.
