

97TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2011 and 2012 HB1570

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

105 ILCS 5/10-20.53 new 105 ILCS 5/34-18.45 new

Amends the School Code. Requires each school board to establish an alternative basic education track focused in mathematics and reading for students performing one grade level or more below their current grade level according to current learning standards and the school district. Requires the State Board of Education to adopt standards for the alternative basic education track. Effective immediately.

STATE MANDATES ACT MAY REQUIRE REIMBURSEMENT 1 AN ACT concerning education.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Sections 10-20.53 and 34-18.45 as follows:

- 8 school board shall establish an alternative basic education
