# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The School Code is amended by changing Section
1A-2.1 as follows:

6 (105 ILCS 5/1A-2.1) (from Ch. 122, par. 1A-2.1)

Sec. 1A-2.1. Vacancies. <u>The</u> The Governor may remove for incompetence, neglect of duty, or malfeasance in office any member of the State Board of Education. A vacancy also exists on the State Board of Education when one or more of the following events occur:

12 1. A member dies.

2. A member files a written resignation with the Governor.

14 3. A member is adjudicated to be a person under legal 15 disability under the Probate Act of 1975 or a person subject to 16 involuntary admission under the Mental Health and 17 Developmental Disabilities Code.

4. A member ceases to be a resident of the region fromwhich he or she was appointed.

5. A member is convicted of an infamous crime or of any offense involving a violation of his or her duties under this Code.
