SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

220 ILCS 5/21-101.1

Amends the Cable and Video Competition Law of 2007 in the Public Utilities Act. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning applicability.

1 AN ACT concerning regulation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Public Utilities Act is amended by changing Section 21-101.1 as follows:
- 6 (220 ILCS 5/21-101.1)
- 7 (Section scheduled to be repealed on October 1, 2013)
- 8 Sec. 21-101.1. Applicability. The The provisions of Public 9 Act 95-9 shall apply only to a holder of a cable service or video service authorization issued by the Commission pursuant 10 to this Article, and shall not apply to any person or entity 11 that provides cable television services under 12 cable а television franchise issued by any municipality or county 13 14 pursuant to Section 11-42-11 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/11-42-11) or Section 5-1095 of the Counties Code (55 15 16 ILCS 5/5-1095), unless specifically provided for herein. A 17 local unit of government that has an existing agreement for the provision of video services with a company or entity that uses 18 19 its telecommunications facilities to provide video service as 20 of May 30, 2007 may continue to operate under that agreement or may, at its discretion, terminate the existing agreement and 21 22 video provider to obtain a State-issued require the authorization under this Article. 2.3
