Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,

represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Exotic Weed Act is amended by
- 5 changing Section 2 as follows:
- 6 (525 ILCS 10/2) (from Ch. 5, par. 932)
- 7 Sec. 2. Definition. Exotic weeds are plants not native to
- 8 North America which, when planted either spread vegetatively or
- 9 naturalize and and degrade natural communities, reduce the
- 10 value of fish and wildlife habitat, or threaten an Illinois
- 11 endangered or threatened species.
