- 8 (a) Every will shall be in writing, signed by the the
- 9 testator or by some person in his presence and by his direction
- 10 and attested in the presence of the testator by 2 or more
- 11 credible witnesses.
- 12 (b) A will that qualifies as an international will under
- 13 the Uniform International Wills Act is considered to meet all
- the requirements of subsection (a).
