1 AN ACT concerning civil law.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Adoption Act is amended by changing Section
3 as follows:

6 (750 ILCS 50/3) (from Ch. 40, par. 1504)

7 Sec. 3. Who may be adopted.

A male or female child, or an adult, may be adopted, 8 9 provided the the other conditions set forth in this Act are 10 met, and further provided, with respect to an adult, that such adult has resided in the home of the persons intending to adopt 11 him at any time for more than 2 years continuously preceding 12 the commencement of an adoption proceeding, or in the 13 14 alternative that such persons are related to him within a degree set forth in the definition of a related child in 15 16 Section 1 of this Act.
