A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 24

5 Section 5. The following named sums, or so much thereof
6 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated to the
7 Supreme Court to pay the ordinary and contingent expenses of
8 certain officers of the court system of Illinois as follows:

9 For Personal Services:

10 Judges' Salaries\$179,550,000

11 For Travel:

12 Judicial Officers1,350,400

14 to Social Security2,603,400

1 Arbitration Fund to the Supreme Court for Mandatory
2 Arbitration Programs.

3 Section 40. The sum of \$140,900, or so much thereof as
4 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Foreign Language
5 Interpreter Fund to the Supreme Court for the Foreign
6 Language Interpreter Program.

7 Section 45. The sum of \$912,400, or so much thereof as
8 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Lawyers'
9 Assistance Program Fund to the Supreme Court for lawyers'
10 assistance programs.

11 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
12 2011.
