2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

3 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of
4 the Secretary of State for any operations, alterations,
5 rehabilitation, and nonrecurring repairs and maintenance of
6 the interior and exterior of the various buildings and
7 facilities under the jurisdiction of the Office of the
8 Secretary of State, including sidewalks, terraces, and
9 grounds and all labor, materials, and other costs incidental
10 to the above work:

11 From General Revenue Fund425,000

12 Section 15. The sum of \$575,000, or so much of this
13 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital
14 Development Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State for
15 new construction and alterations, and maintenance of the
16 interiors and exteriors of the following facilities under the
17 jurisdiction of the Secretary of State: Chicago West
18 Facility, 5301 N. Lexington Ave., Chicago, Illinois 60644;
19 Roger McAuliffe Facility, 5401 N. Elston Ave., Chicago,

20 Section 70. The sum of \$250,000, or so much of this
21 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General
22 Revenue Fund to the Office of Secretary of State for the

1 Penny Severns Summer Family Literacy Grants.

2 Section 75. In addition to any other amounts
3 appropriated for such purposes, the sum of \$1,432,000, or so
4 much of this amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from
5 the General Revenue Fund to the Office of the Secretary of
6 State for a grant to the Chicago Public Library.

7 Section 80. The sum of \$325,000, or so much of this
8 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General
9 Revenue Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State for all
10 expenditures and grants to libraries for the Project Next
11 Generation Program.

12 Section 85. The following amount, or so much of this
13 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of
14 the Secretary of State from the Live and Learn Fund for the
15 purpose of promotion of organ and tissue donations:

16 From Live and Learn Fund1,750,000

17 Section 90. The sum of \$50,000, or so much of this amount
18 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Secretary of
19 State Special License Plate Fund to the Office of the
20 Secretary of State for grants to benefit Illinois Veterans
21 Home libraries.

1 Section 95. The amount of \$50,000, or so much of this
2 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of
3 the Secretary of State from the Master Mason Fund to provide
4 grants to the Illinois Masonic Foundation for the Prevention
5 of Drug and Alcohol Abuse Among Children, Inc., a not-for-
6 profit corporation, for the purpose of providing Model
7 Student Assistance Programs in public and private schools in
8 Illinois.

9 Section 100. The amount of \$75,000, or so much thereof as
10 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State
11 from the Illinois Pan Hellenic Trust Fund to provide grants
12 for charitable purposes sponsored by African-American
13 fraternities and sororities.

14 Section 105. The amount of \$35,000, or so much thereof as
15 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State
16 from the Park District Youth Program Fund to provide grants
17 for the Illinois Association of Park Districts: After School
18 Programming.

19 Section 110. The amount of \$110,000, or so much thereof
20 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of
21 State from the Illinois Route 66 Heritage Project Fund to

1 provide grants for the development of tourism, education,
2 preservation and promotion of Route 66.

3 Section 115. The sum of \$200,000, or so much of this
4 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Police
5 Memorial Committee Fund to the Office of the Secretary of
6 State for grants to the Police Memorial Committee for
7 maintaining a memorial statue, holding an annual memorial
8 commemoration, and giving scholarships to children of police
9 officers killed in the line of duty.

10 Section 120. The sum of \$140,000, or so much of this
11 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
12 Mammogram Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State for
13 grants to the Susan G. Komen Foundation for breast cancer
14 research, education, screening, and treatment.

15 Section 125. The following amounts, or so much of these
16 amounts as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
17 to the Office of the Secretary of State for such purposes in
18 Section 3-646 of the Illinois Vehicle Code (625 ILCS 5), for
19 grants to the Regional Organ Bank of Illinois and to Mid-
20 America Transplant Services for the purpose of promotion of
21 organ and tissue donation awareness. These amounts are in
22 addition to any amounts otherwise appropriated to the Office

1 of the Secretary of State:

2 From Organ Donor Awareness Fund200,000

3 Section 130. The amount of \$500, or so much thereof as
4 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State
5 from the Chicago and Northeast Illinois District Council of
6 Carpenters Fund to provide grants for charitable purposes.

7 Section 135. The amount of \$70,000, or so much thereof as
8 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State
9 from the U.S. Marine Corps Scholarship Fund to provide grants
10 for scholarships for Higher Education.

11 Section 140. The amount of \$700,000, or so much of this
12 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the SOS
13 Federal Projects Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State
14 for the payment of any operational expenses relating to the
15 cost incident to augmenting the Illinois Commercial Motor
16 Vehicle safety program by assuring and verifying the identity
17 of drivers prior to licensure, including CDL operators; for
18 improved security for Drivers Licenses and Personal
19 Identification Cards; and any other related program deemed
20 appropriate by the Office of the Secretary of State.

21 Section 145. The amount of \$2,333,500, or so much of this

1 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of
2 the Secretary of State from the Securities Investors
3 Education Fund for any expenses used to promote public
4 awareness of the dangers of securities fraud.

5 Section 150. The amount of \$5,000, or so much of this
6 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of
7 the Secretary of State from the Secretary of State Evidence
8 Fund for the purchase of evidence, for the employment of
9 persons to obtain evidence, and for the payment for any goods
10 or services related to obtaining evidence.

11 Section 155. The amount of \$225,000, or so much thereof
12 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Alternate Fuels
13 Fund to the Office of Secretary of State for the cost of
14 administering the Alternate Fuels Act.

15 Section 160. The amount of \$17,124,000, or so much of
16 this amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
17 Secretary of State Special Services Fund to the Office of the
18 Secretary of State for office automation and technology.

19 Section 165. The amount of \$15,561,600, or so much of
20 this amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
21 Motor Vehicle License Plate Fund to the Office of the

1 Secretary of State for the cost incident to providing new or
2 replacement plates for motor vehicles.

3 Section 170. The sum of \$2,500,000, or so much of this
4 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
5 Secretary of State DUI Administration Fund to the Office of
6 Secretary of State for operation of the Department of
7 Administrative Hearings of the Office of Secretary of State
8 and for no other purpose.

9 Section 175. The amount of \$30,000, or so much thereof as
10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Secretary of State
11 Police DUI Fund to the Secretary of State for the payments of
12 goods and services that will assist in the prevention of
13 alcohol-related criminal violence throughout the State.

14 Section 180. The amount of \$350,000 is appropriated from
15 the Secretary of State Police Services Fund to the Secretary
16 of State for purposes as indicated by the grantor or
17 contractor or, in the case of money bequeathed or granted for
18 no specific purpose, for any purpose as deemed appropriate by
19 the Director of Police, Secretary of State in administering
20 the responsibilities of the Secretary of State Department of
21 Police.

1 Section 185. The amount of \$500,000, or so much of this
 2 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Office
 3 of the Secretary of State Grant Fund to the Office of the
 4 Secretary of State to be expended in accordance with the
 5 terms and conditions upon which such funds were received.

6 Section 190. The amount of \$24,300, or so much of this
 7 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of
 8 the Secretary of State from the State Library Fund to
 9 increase the collection of books, records, and holdings; to
 10 hold public forums; to purchase equipment and resource
 11 materials for the State Library; and for the upkeep, repair,
 12 and maintenance of the State Library building and grounds.

13 Section 195. The following amount, or so much of this
 14 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of
 15 the Secretary of State for any operations, alterations,
 16 rehabilitations, new construction, and maintenance of the
 17 interior and exterior of the various buildings and facilities
 18 under the jurisdiction of the Secretary of State to enhance
 19 security measures in the Capitol Complex:

20 From General Revenue Fund3,500,000

21 Section 200. The amount of \$15,000,000, or so much of
 22 that amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the

1 Secretary of State Identification Security and Theft
2 Prevention Fund to the Office of Secretary of State for all
3 costs related to implementing identification security and
4 theft prevention measures.

5 Section 205 The sum of \$3,000,000, or so much of this
6 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
7 Monitoring Device Driving Permit Administration Fee Fund to
8 the Office of the Secretary of State for all Secretary of
9 State costs associated with administering Monitoring Device
10 Driving Permits per Public Act 95-0400.

11 Section 210. The sum of \$500,000, or so much of this
12 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Indigent
13 BAIID Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State to
14 reimburse ignition interlock device providers per Public Act
15 95-0400.

16 Section 215. The amount of \$35,000, or so much thereof as
17 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State
18 from the Illinois Professional Golfers Association Junior
19 Golf Fund for grants to the Illinois Professional Golfers
20 Association Foundation to help Association members expose
21 Illinois youngsters to the game of golf.

1 Section 220. The amount of \$60,000, or so much thereof as
2 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State
3 from the Agriculture in the Classroom Fund for grants to
4 support Agriculture in the Classroom programming for public
5 and private schools within Illinois.

6 Section 225. The amount of \$10,000, or so much thereof as
7 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State
8 from the Boy Scout and Girl Scout Fund for grants to the
9 Illinois divisions of the Boy Scouts of America and the Girl
10 Scouts of the U.S.A.

11 Section 230. The amount of \$5,000, or so much thereof as
12 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State
13 from the Support Our Troops Fund for grants to Illinois
14 Support Our Troops, Inc. for charitable assistance to the
15 troops and their families in accordance with its Articles of
16 Incorporation.

17 Section 235. The amount of \$5,000, or so much thereof as
18 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State
19 from the Illinois EMS Memorial Scholarship and Training Fund
20 for grants to the EMS Memorial Scholarship and Training
21 Council for providing scholarships for graduate study,
22 undergraduate study, or both, to children and spouses of

1 emergency medical services (EMS) personnel killed in the
2 course of their employment and for grants for the training of
3 EMS personnel.

4 Section 240. The amount of \$5,000, or so much of this
5 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of
6 the Secretary of State from the Rotary Club Fund for grants
7 for charitable purposes sponsored by the Rotary Club.

8 Section 245. The amount of \$5,000, or so much of this
9 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of
10 the Secretary of State from the Ovarian Cancer Awareness Fund
11 for grants to the National Ovarian Cancer Coalition, Inc. for
12 ovarian cancer research, education, screening, and treatment.

13 Section 250. The amount of \$3,000, or so much of this
14 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of
15 the Secretary of State from the Sheet Metal Workers
16 International Association of Illinois Fund for grants for
17 charitable purposes sponsored by Illinois chapters of the
18 Sheet Metal Workers International Association.

19 Section 255. The amount of \$30,000, or so much of this
20 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of
21 the Secretary of State from the Illinois Police Association

1 Fund for providing death benefits for the families of police
2 officers killed in the line of duty, and for providing
3 scholarships, for graduate study, undergraduate study, or
4 both, to children and spouses of police officers killed in
5 the line of duty.

6 Section 260. The amount of \$4,000, or so much thereof as
7 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State
8 from the International Brotherhood of Teamsters Fund for
9 grants to the Teamsters Joint Council 25 Charitable Trust for
10 religious, charitable, scientific, literary, and educational
11 purposes.

12 Section 265. The amount of \$500, or so much thereof as
13 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State
14 from the United Auto Workers' Fund for grants for charitable
15 purposes sponsored by Illinois local unions affiliated with
16 the United Auto Workers.

17 Section 270. The amount of \$5,000, or so much thereof as
18 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State
19 from the Autism Awareness Fund for grants to the Illinois
20 Department of Human Services for the purpose of grants for
21 research, education, and awareness regarding autism and
22 autism spectrum disorders.

1 Section 275. The amount of \$20,000, or so much thereof as
2 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State
3 from the Share the Road Fund for grants to the League of
4 Illinois Bicyclists, a not for profit corporation, for
5 educational programs instructing bicyclists and motorists how
6 to legally and more safely share the roadways.

7 Section 280. The sum of \$50,000,000, or so much thereof
8 as may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of
9 business on June 30, 2011, from an appropriation heretofore
10 made for such purpose in Article 106, Section 5 of Public Act
11 96-0956, as amended, is reappropriated from the Build
12 Illinois Bond Fund to the Secretary of State for capital
13 grants to public libraries for permanent improvements.

14 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
15 2011.
