Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 15. The sum of \$25,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission from the Education Assistance Fund for payment of Monetary Award Program grant awards to students eligible to receive such awards, as provided by law.

- 3 as part of the College Cost Reduction and Access Act (CCRAA),
