### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Makes appropriations for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2011, as follows:

# Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

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#### ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much 6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects 7 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Illinois Criminal 8 Justice Information Authority: 9 10 OPERATIONS Payable from General Revenue Fund: 11 12 13 For State Contributions to 14 15 16 17 18 19 20 21 

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3 Section 15. The sum of \$40,000,000, or so much thereof 4 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Criminal 5 Justice Trust Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice 6 Information Authority for awards and grants to local units of 7 government and non-profit organizations.

8 Section 20. The additional sum of \$500,000, or so much 9 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the 10 Criminal Justice Trust Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice 11 Information Authority for Crime Victims Assistance awards and 12 local units of government and grants to non-profit organizations in accordance with 13 applicable laws and 14 regulations for the State portion of federal funds made 15 available by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 16 2009.

17 Section 25. The additional sum of \$4,600,000, or so much 18 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Criminal Justice Trust Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice 19 Information Authority for Violence Against Women awards and 20 21 grants to local units of government and non-profit 22 organizations in accordance with applicable laws and HB2169 -3- OMB097 00075 YAS 40075 b regulations for the State portion of federal funds made available by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009.

Section 30. The additional sum of \$23,000,000, or so 4 5 much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Criminal Justice Trust Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice 6 Information Authority for Byrne/JAG awards and grants to 7 8 local units of government and non-profit organizations in accordance with applicable laws and regulations for the State 9 10 portion of federal funds made available by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009. 11

12 Section 35. The sum of \$12,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Criminal 13 14 Justice Trust Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice 15 Authority for awards Information and grants to state 16 agencies.

17 Section 40. The additional sum of \$500,000, or so much 18 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the 19 Criminal Justice Trust Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice 20 Information Authority for Violence Against Women awards and 21 grants to state agencies in accordance with applicable laws 22 and regulations for the State portion of federal funds made HB2169 -4- OMB097 00075 YAS 40075 b 1 available by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2 2009.

Section 45. The additional sum of \$15,000,000, or so 3 much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the 4 5 Criminal Justice Trust Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for Byrne/JAG awards and grants to 6 state agencies in accordance with applicable laws 7 and 8 regulations for the State portion of federal funds made 9 available by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 10 2009.

11 Section 50. The following named sums, or so much thereof 12 as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Illinois 13 Criminal Justice Information Authority for activities 14 undertaken in support of federal assistance programs 15 administered by units of state and local government and non-16 profit organizations:

Section 65. The sum of \$4,500,000, or so much thereof as 11 may be necessary, is appropriated from 12 the Juvenile Accountability Incentive Block Grant Trust Fund to the 13 Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for awards 14 15 and grants to state agencies and units of local government, including operational expenses of the Authority in support of 16 17 the Juvenile Accountability Incentive Block Grant program.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 2011.
