Amends the Railroad Incorporation Act. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning the incorporation of a company for the purpose of constructing and operating railroads.

1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Railroad Incorporation Act is amended by changing Section 1 as follows:
- 6 (610 ILCS 5/1) (from Ch. 114, par. 1)
- 7 Sec. 1. Any number of persons, not less than 5, may become 8 an incorporated company for for the purpose of constructing and 9 operating any railroad in this state, and all railroads or 10 transportation companies authorized to be incorporated and transact business in this state by virtue of this Act, are 11 12 hereby authorized and empowered to purchase, own, operate and maintain any railroad sold or transferred under order or powers 13 14 of sale or judgment of, or sale under foreclosure of mortgage or deed of trust, and corporations heretofore organized under 15 16 the provisions of the Act hereby amended, their successors or 17 assigns, shall have and possess all the powers and privileges conferred by this Act. 18
