- 7 Sec. 35. Increased Ethanol Content Encouragement Program.
- 8 (a) The General Assembly finds:
- 9 (1) Due to the increasing cost of motor fuel, gas
 10 stations in the State should be encouraged to offer motor
 11 fuel blended with 15% ethanol. Increasing the percentage of
 12 ethanol in motor fuel will help to reduce the cost of motor
 13 fuel.
 - (2) Existing studies show that some higher percentage blends of ethanol may be used in motor vehicles without requiring any modification to the vehicle.
 - (3) Motor vehicle manufacturers are encouraged to continue to expand production of flexible-fuel vehicles.

 Flexible-fuel vehicles are capable of using any blend of ethanol fuel up to 85% ethanol.
 - (4) The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency announced E15 motor fuel blends to be safe for use in all cars and pickup trucks produced in 2001 and later. With this

- announcement, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency has 1
- 2 approved the use of E15 for 62% of vehicles on the road
- 3 today.
- 4 (b) The Department may provide information to gas stations
- 5 in the State encouraging the gas stations to offer E15 blended
- fuel as an option for customers. The Department may provide gas 6
