1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 3308

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 3308 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Department of Revenue Law of the Civil
5 Administrative Code of Illinois is amended by adding Section
6 2505-735 as follows:

7 (20 ILCS 2505/2505-735 new)

8 Sec. 2505-735. Assistance to other State agencies
9 concerning alternative fuel. In cooperation with the Illinois
10 Environmental Agency, the Department of Transportation, the
11 Secretary of State, and any other applicable State agency, the
12 Department shall provide a listing of alternative fuel
13 dispensing locations in the State to the Department of
14 Transportation in a manner and format prescribed by the
15 Department of Transportation so that the information may be
16 disseminated according to Section 4-101.13 of the Illinois

1 Highway Code. The Department shall provide an updated listing
2 biannually to the Department of Transportation.

3 Section 10. The Illinois Highway Code is amended by
4 changing Section 4-101.13 as follows:

5 (605 ILCS 5/4-101.13) (from Ch. 121, par. 4-101.13)

6 Sec. 4-101.13. To publish maps in convenient forms showing
7 State and other highways for use by the public and, in its
8 discretion, to fix a charge therefor not in excess of the cost
9 of publication. The Department shall determine the content of
10 all maps published by the Department and shall be permitted to
11 provide on its official website additional information that is
12 made available to the Department regarding dispensing
13 locations that provide E85 blended fuel or biodiesel fuel. The
14 Department shall update its website at least biannually so long
15 as it receives timely updates from the Department of Revenue on
16 alternative fueling dispensing locations in the State.

18 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
19 becoming law."
