

97TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2011 and 2012 HB3406

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

815 ILCS 505/2LLL new

Amends the Consumer Fraud and Deceptive Business Practices Act. Provides that any person who offers a rebate to consumers at retail on any merchandise must conspicuously display and clearly disclose to the consumer the type of rebate being offered, whether additional fees may apply on the rebate offered, and the form of remittance that will be provided to the consumer. Provides that a person who violates those provisions commits an unlawful practice within the meaning of the Act.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Consumer Fraud and Deceptive Business
 Practices Act is amended by adding Section 2LLL as follows:
- 6 (815 ILCS 505/2LLL new)
- Sec. 2LLL. Retail rebates. Any person who offers a rebate
 to consumers at retail on any merchandise must conspicuously
 display and clearly disclose to the consumer the type of rebate
 being offered, whether additional fees may apply on the rebate
 offered, and the form of remittance that will be provided to
 the consumer. Any person who violates this Section commits an
- unlawful practice within the meaning of this Act.
