Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4	Section 5. The sum of \$29,000,000, or so much thereof as
5	may be necessary, is appropriated from the Tobacco Settlement
6	Recovery Fund to the Department of Public Health for the
7	purposes specified at the costs set forth below:
8	For local health departments with a plan
9	in accordance with the Centers for Disease
10	Control and Prevention's Best Practices
11	for Comprehensive Tobacco Control Programs 8,000,000
12	For non-profit organizations that demonstrate
13	an ability to mobilize community residents
14	in accordance with the Centers for Disease
15	Control and Prevention's Best Practices
16	for Comprehensive Tobacco Control Programs7,000,000
17	For a statewide media campaign utilizing the
18	Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's
19	Media Resource Center and other evidence-based
20	Programs 6,000,000
21	For the Illinois Coalition Against Tobacco to
22	provide technical assistance to local health
23	departments and community grantees

1	For support of a statewide tobacco cessation

3	For an outside evaluator
4	For implementation and enforcement of the
5	Smoke Free Illinois Act
