Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Criminal Code of 1961 is amended by adding Sections 10-10 and 10-11 as follows:

- Sec. 10-10. Failure to report the disappearance of a child to a law enforcement agency.
- 9 (a) A person commits failure to report the disappearance of

 10 a child to a law enforcement agency when he or she, as a

 11 parent, guardian, or other person having physical custody or

 12 control of a child under 13 years of age, knowingly or

 13 recklessly fails to immediately report the child as missing to

 14 a law enforcement agency after a 48-hour period expires in

 15 which he or she failed to make contact with or otherwise verify
- 16 the whereabouts and safety of that child.
- 17 <u>(b) A person does not commit failure to report the</u>
 18 <u>disappearance of a child to a law enforcement agency when the</u>
 19 <u>failure to report is due to an act of God, act of war, or</u>
 20 <u>inability of a law enforcement agency to receive a report of</u>
- 21 <u>the disappearance of a child.</u>
- 22 <u>(c) A person does not commit failure to report the</u>
 23 disappearance of a child to a law enforcement agency when the

- person calls 911 to report the disappearance of the child or 1
- 2 knows that the child is under the care of another parent,
- family member, relative, friend, or baby sitter. 3
- 4 (d) Sentence. Failure to report the disappearance of a
- 5 child to a law enforcement agency is a Class 4 felony.

- 7 Sec. 10-11. Death of a child or location of a child's
- 8 corpse.
- 9 (a) A parent, quardian, or other person having physical
- 10 custody or control of a child under 18 years of age must
- 11 report:
- (1) the child's death to a law enforcement agency 12
- within one hour after learning about the child's death; or 1.3
- (2) the location of the child's corpse to a law 14
- 15 enforcement agency within one hour after learning the
- 16 location of the corpse.
- (b) A person does not violate this Section when he or she 17
- fails to report due to an act of God, act of war, or inability 18
- of a law enforcement agency to receive a report of a child's 19
- 20 death or the location of a child's corpse.
- 21 (c) A person does not violate this Section when he or she
- 22 calls 911 to report the death of the child or if the death of
- 23 the child occurs in a hospital or if the child's body is in the
- 24 custody of a medical examiner or coroner, or if the death
- 25 occurs in the care of a physician.

- 1 (d) Sentence. A violation of this Section is a Class 4
- 2 felony.
