SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

65 ILCS 115/10-2 65 ILCS 115/10-5.3

Amends the River Edge Redevelopment Zone Act. Provides that, on and after the effective date of the amendatory Act, the Department may certify an additional pilot River Edge Redevelopment Zone in the City of Alton. Effective immediately.

AN ACT concerning local government.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The River Edge Redevelopment Zone Act is amended
by changing Sections 10-2 and 10-5.3 as follows:

6 (65 ILCS 115/10-2)

7 Sec. 10-2. Findings. The General Assembly finds and 8 declares that those municipalities adjacent to or surrounding 9 river areas often lack critical tools to safely revive and redevelop environmentally-challenged properties that will 10 stimulate economic revitalization and create jobs in Illinois. 11 12 Environmentally-challenged properties adjacent to or 13 surrounding Illinois rivers are a threat to the health, safety, 14 and welfare of the people of this State. Many of these 15 environmentally-challenged properties adjacent to or 16 surrounding rivers were former industrial areas that now, 17 subject to appropriate environmental clean-up and remediation, would be ideal for office, residential, retail, hospitality, 18 19 commercial, recreational, warehouse and distribution, and other economically productive uses. The cost of the cleaning 20 21 and remediation of these environmentally-challenged properties 22 is often the primary obstacle to returning these properties to a safe and economically productive use. 23

Cooperative and continuous partnership among the State, 1 2 through the Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity and the Environmental Protection Agency, municipalities adjacent 3 to or surrounding rivers, and the private sector is necessary 4 to appropriately encourage the cost-effective cleaning and 5 remediation of these environmentally-challenged properties in 6 7 order to bring about a safe and economically productive use of 8 the properties.

9 Therefore, it is declared to be the purpose of this Act to 10 identify and initiate 3 pilot River Edge Redevelopment Zones to 11 stimulate the safe and cost-effective of re-use 12 environmentally-challenged properties adjacent to or surrounding rivers by means of tax incentives or grants. On or 13 14 after July 28, 2011 (the effective date of Public Act 97-203) this amendatory Act of the 97th General Assembly, 15 the 16 Department may certify an additional pilot River Edge 17 Redevelopment Zone in the City of Peoria. On or after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 97th General 18 19 Assembly, the Department may certify an additional pilot River Edge Redevelopment Zone in the City of Alton. 20

23 Sec. 10-5.3. Certification of River Edge Redevelopment 24 Zones.

25 (a) Approval of designated River Edge Redevelopment Zones

shall be made by the Department by certification of the 1 2 designating ordinance. The Department shall promptly issue a 3 certificate for each zone upon its approval. The certificate shall be signed by the Director of the Department, shall make 4 5 specific reference to the designating ordinance, which shall be 6 attached thereto, and shall be filed in the office of the 7 Secretary of State. A certified copy of the River Edge 8 Redevelopment Zone Certificate, or a duplicate original 9 thereof, shall be recorded in the office of the recorder of 10 deeds of the county in which the River Edge Redevelopment Zone 11 lies.

(b) A River Edge Redevelopment Zone shall be effective upon its certification. The Department shall transmit a copy of the certification to the Department of Revenue, and to the designating municipality. Upon certification of a River Edge Redevelopment Zone, the terms and provisions of the designating ordinance shall be in effect, and may not be amended or repealed except in accordance with Section 10-5.4.

(c) A River Edge Redevelopment Zone shall be in effect for the period stated in the certificate, which shall in no event exceed 30 calendar years. Zones shall terminate at midnight of December 31 of the final calendar year of the certified term, except as provided in Section 10-5.4.

(d) In calendar years 2006 and 2007, the Department may
certify one pilot River Edge Redevelopment Zone in the City of
East St. Louis, one pilot River Edge Redevelopment Zone in the

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City of Rockford, and one pilot River Edge Redevelopment Zone
 in the City of Aurora.

In calendar year 2009, the Department may certify one pilot
River Edge Redevelopment Zone in the City of Elgin.

5 On or after <u>July 28,2011 (the effective date of <u>Public Act</u> 6 <u>97-203)</u> this amendatory Act of the 97th General Assembly, the 7 Department may certify one additional pilot River Edge 8 Redevelopment Zone in the City of Peoria.</u>

9 <u>On or after the effective date of this amendatory Act of</u> 10 <u>the 97th General Assembly, the Department may certify one</u> 11 <u>additional pilot River Edge Redevelopment Zone in the City of</u> 12 <u>Alton.</u>

13 Thereafter the Department may not certify any additional 14 River Edge Redevelopment Zones, but may amend and rescind 15 certifications of existing River Edge Redevelopment Zones in 16 accordance with Section 10-5.4.

17 (e) A municipality in which a River Edge Redevelopment Zone has been certified must submit to the Department, within 60 18 days after the certification, a plan for encouraging the 19 20 participation by minority persons, females, persons with disabilities, and veterans in the zone. The Department may 21 22 assist the municipality in developing and implementing the 23 plan. The terms "minority person", "female", and "person with a disability" have the meanings set forth under Section 2 of the 24 25 Business Enterprise for Minorities, Females, and Persons with Disabilities Act. "Veteran" means an Illinois resident who is a 26
