Service animals such as 8 quide dogs, signal dogs or any other animal individually 9 trained to perform tasks for the benefit of a student with a disability shall be permitted to accompany that student at all 10 school functions, whether in or outside the classroom. For the 11 purposes of this Section, "service animal" has the same meaning 12 as in Section 1 of the Service Animal Access Act. 13

When a blind, hearing impaired or physically 5 handicapped person with a physical, mental, or intellectual 6 disability requiring the use of a service animal or a person 7 8 who is subject to epilepsy or other seizure disorders is 9 accompanied by <u>a service animal</u> a dog which serves as a guide, 10 leader, seizure-alert, or seizure-response dog for such person 11 or when a trainer of a service animal quide, leader, 12 seizure-alert, or seizure-response dog is accompanied by a guide, leader, seizure-alert, or 13 service animal 14 seizure-response dog or a dog that is being trained to be a 15 quide, leader, seizure alert, or seizure response dog, neither 16 the person nor the service animal dog shall be denied the right of entry and use of facilities of any public place of 17 accommodation as defined in Section 5-101 of the "Illinois 18 Human Rights Act", if such animal dog is wearing a harness, 19 20 backpack, or vest identifying it as a service animal and such 21 person presents credentials for inspection issued by a school 22 for training quide, leader, seizure-alert, or seizure-response 23 <del>dogs</del>.
